Matters discussed:

- Initial discussion regarding name for the Group. It was decided on 'South Wales and Borders Dutch Spotted Group' as to include as many breeders as possible near/in Mid and South Wales and those on the English borders.
- Purpose of group to provide encouragement and training for breeders in this area whilst promoting and supporting the main DSS Society.

- Discussion on how to promote this group and how to encourage more breeders to attend next meeting.

- Discussion on Embryo Transfer (ET) as some breeders worried about the restraints on genetic diversity within the breed.
- How we could further advertise the commercial potential of the DSS lambs as a whole.
- Exploring the possibility of classes for lambs sired by DS carcass/live at Winter Fair
- Discussion that the main DSS association need to agree and promote breed standards throughout the UK.
- Initial SW & Borders event to be an 'Open Day' during late spring/early summer.
